Our Classes Prepare You For These Employment Positions

SIX UNITS:

- 6 Units = substitute preschool teacher.
- 6 units + continuing enrollment = provisional preschool teacher.
- 6 units in Infant Development and Child Development + continuing enrollment = provisional infant teacher.

TWELVE UNITS with 6 months experience:

- 12 units including core classes = preschool teacher.
- The same 12 units = school-age child care teacher.
- 12 units in core classes with Infant development = infant teacher.

FIFTEEN UNITS with 4 years experience:

- 15 units, as above, plus Supervision & Administration = Center director.
- 15 units as above, with Supervision & Administration AND Infant Development = Infant Center Director.

Admission Requirements

- Student must have a high school diploma/G.E.D or BA Degree and be at least 18 years of age.
- Photo ID required
- California College of Early Childhood Education offers classes in English only. No English as a Second Language courses are available. English Language services are not provided.
- The College requires English as a second language students to take the TOEFL IBT test. The cost is \$185. Students can access the website to register for the test at www.sts.org/toefl. It takes a little over 4 hours to complete. The minimum score for admission is 61.
